Includes: 2018 Program and Seasons Pass to be picked up before or during festival  
and 2019 Syllabus mailed to you.

(Note: Only ONE SEASON PASS per studio will be issued, replacements must be paid for)

**No Programs will be mailed out, all will need to be picked up either prior or during the competitions. Program Vouchers and Teachers' Passes will be mailed to those that live out of Chilliwack area.**

**NOTE:** Any studio/teacher overages under \$50 will be given out  
in bursary funds by festival in the same year.

### PENALTY FEES

\$5 penalty fee per entry for incomplete/incorrect information on entry forms.

\$20 penalty fee per entry for class changes to any entry after December 20<sup>th</sup>.

### TROPHIES & SHIELD RETURNS

Shields and Trophies are the property of the Chilliwack Lions Club Music and Dance Festival and are to be competed for annually. Please have your shields and trophies engraved early. Winners MUST return trophies in the same condition as presented, so please clean, polish and repair before returning.

#### **ALL SHIELDS AND TROPHIES WON IN 2017 MUST BE RETURNED BY DECEMBER 1, 2017.**

If not returned by December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017 there will be a \$25 penalty charged. If not returned by January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018, participants will not be eligible to perform in the current year's festival.

A WORKSHOP IS TO FOLLOW EACH DIVISION AND IS INCLUDED IN CLASS FEE.

### UKULELE RULES

1. A competitor must compete in their current level of study.

Each competitor must supply the Adjudicator with a copy of the piece to be played. No Photocopies are allowed for the student, Adjudicator or accompanist. Please use original scores only. (Tablature and chord symbols are acceptable in this division.)

2. If time limit will allow, 2 or 3 contrasting pieces may be played.

3. **OWN COMPOSITION** For solo instrument, vocal, instruments with piano accompaniment or any combination of chamber instruments.

A copy of the composition MUST be received by the Festival Registrar by February 1<sup>st</sup> in order to mail to the adjudicator for perusal. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** More than one entry per contestant is allowed as long as they represent different disciplines. (New 2016)

#### FEE SCHEDULE for SOLO ENTRIES:

Novice – Non-Competitive	\$25.00 per class
Intermediate	\$30.00 per class
Advanced and Open	\$35.00 per class
Own Composition Fees	\$30.00 per class

NOVICE - Non-Competitive	2 years of study or less	TIME LIMIT - 5 Minutes
INTERMEDIATE	4 years of study or less	TIME LIMIT - 7 Minutes
OPEN	5 years of study or more	TIME LIMIT - 12 Minutes

Years of study refers to the years playing on the instrument, not to private instruction only.

#### FEE SCHEDULE for UKULELE ENSEMBLES:

2 – 3 Performers	\$30.00
4 – 8 Performers	\$45.00
9 – 14 Performers	\$70.00
15 or more Performers	\$100.00

No limit on number of ukulele players for Unison Groups or Ukulele Ensembles. Ukulele Unison and Ensembles can be accompanied by one other instrument as well as a bass instrument with unlimited use of voice by players. Ukulele needs to be the featured instrument throughout the performance.

1. One or more selections will be allowed within the given time limit.
2. Selections in the Ukulele Ensemble Section ONLY may be labeled TBA. If using TBA for Selections, the title and composer must be announced clearly by the conductor before each piece is performed.
